After a summer of rising gas prices, polls show that an overwhelming majority of Americans demand that Congress take action.

Instead of drilling for more oil, they support a plan that will make us even more dependent on foreign oil, and increases energy taxes.

It's called the "Gang of 10" plan, and Senators Saxby Chambliss and Johnny Isakson support it.

The "Gang of 10" plan only opens a tiny portion of America's oil reserves — leaving vast offshore resources untapped.

Even worse, the "Gang of 10" plan imposes \$30 billion in new energy taxes.¹ Higher taxes will discourage energy exploration and make us even more dependent on nations like Iran and Russia.

And new taxes will trigger the loss of more than 600,000 American jobs at a time when our economy is already struggling, and unemployment is rising sharply.¹
